DAY TWO OF THE INTERNATIONAL ANTI-CORRUPTION DAY COMMEMORATION



Day 2 of the Commemoration of the 2022 International Anti-Corruption Day took place on 09 December 2022 under the theme *“The Cost of Failure of Governance, Ethics and Oversight: A collective response to tackle the scourge of corruption in the Public Sector”*. The event aimed to provide an opportunity for government, political leaders, business, civil society, academia, the public and youth to join forces against corruption.

The Chief Justice of the Republic of South Africa Judge RMM Zondo addressed the delegates and he reflected on the impact of corruption on society and the role of the judiciary.
