## PSC HOLDS FOCUS GROUP ON PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION REFORMS



The Public Service Commission (PSC) held a Focus Group discussions on Public Administration Reform and the Professionalisation of Public Sector: A Public Service Commission. These sessions took place between 2nd and 3rd August 2023, at the Public Service Commission House in Pretoria.

The purpose of the Focus Group was to solicit inputs from current and former Commissioners of the Public Service Commission, current and former Directors-General, various experts in Academia, Organised Labour and retired senior public servants, for the PSC's draft report.

The discussions were robust and extensive. The platform has created a very good relations with experts who were in general very welcoming to the recommendations emanating from the report.

The draft report focuses on issues relating to Human Resource Management amongst others.

The inputs emanating from the experts, including suggestions on future public administration reforms, will be incorporated into the report which will be presented at the Conference on the 12th October 2023 for further inputs. The report also aims to improve reforms in order to ensure that the public sector is an institution that delivers quality services to improve the lives of the people.
