PSC ATTENDS THE 21ST INTERNATIONAL ANTI-CORRUPTION CONFERENCE IN LITHUANIA



On Tuesday, 18 June 2024, Commissioner Yasmin Bacus attended the opening ceremony of the 21st International Anti-Corruption Conference (IACC) in Vilnius, Lithuania. The Conference is held from 18-21 June 2024 under the theme *“Confronting Global Threats: Standing Up for Integrity”*.

The opening ceremony featured the leaders of Transparency International, World Bank, United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime, United States Agency for International Development, the Chairman of the IACC including the global community of corruption fighters from civil Society organizations, the public and private sectors and diverse academic organizations that offer formal training on Ethics and Integrity Management.

South Africa is playing a key role at the conference outlining laws and reform process on whistle-blowing



including analysing various corruption indicators being applied to different countries. Dr Liezel Groenewald from the Ethics Institute will lead a session on Strengthening Legal Protection Frameworks for Whistle-blowers during day 2 of the conference.
